

U. S. ARMY FIELD MESSAGE.

From: Insite Eleven
At: P.C. 30.1-81.2
Date: 11-11-18 Hour 9-45 No.1.

To: Incited One

You will proceed and attack Ville Devont Chaumont. Hostilities will cease on the whole front at 11 H today French time. Until that hour the operations ordered will be pressed vigorously. At 11 H our lines will halt in place and no man will move one step backward or forward. He will stay exactly where he is. All men will cease firing and dig in. In case enemy does not likewise suspend firing--firing will be resumed but no further advance will be permitted. No fraternization will be allowed. Brigade and other commanders concerned are charged with the important duty of transmitting these orders to the troops and securing their strict enforcement. Rockets or other signals may be used to notify front lines of the arrival of the 11 H. Just as soon as possible after 11 H determine exact trace of front lines by co-ordinates and indicate exact position of flanks, liaison groups, notify these Hqrs at once.

Do not forget to send us information of what happens. The 26th Division will be on your right and the 1st Bn. 313th on your left.

Col. Rogers direct that you proceed with your Bn. to Moirey at once, from there get in communication with Regtl. Hqrs. at advanced P. C.

Hostilities will cease on the whole front at 11 A.M. today and at that hour all troops will halt where they are and dig in. Under no circumstances will a shot be fired after that hour.
